The affected territory is uninhabited as defined by Section 56045 of the Government Code; and

The Executive Officer did set the proposal for hearing on September 5, 1984 and did give notice at the time and in the manner prescribed by law; and

The Executive Officer did review the application filed with him and did prepare a report, including his recommendations, thereon; and

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, the Commission has categorically exempted the proposal, Section 19

_____ ; and

The Commission, at their meeting(s) on September 5, 1984 - October 1, continued to held a public hearing as noticed, and heard and received all oral and written protests, objections or evidence which were made, presented, or filed, and considered the report of the Executive Officer and the plan for providing municipal services to the territory.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that:

The proposed Rasmussen Lane Annexation to the City of Fort Bragg

is approved _____ with the following amendments and/or conditions:

- a. Area be detached from the Fort Bragg Rural Fire District

The City of Fort Bragg is designated as the conducting authority and is directed to initiate proceedings pursuant to the District Reorganization Act, in Sections 56290 et. seq. of the Government Code; and

The Executive Officer shall mail a certified copy of this Resolution to:

- a. The conducting authority;
- b. The chief petitioners, if any; and,
- c. Each affected city, county and district.
