

RESOLUTION NO. 76-4

RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION
OPPOSING SENATE BILL 1736

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1736 by Senator Smith would make major modifications in the Knox-Nesbit Act and other provisions in relation to Local Agency Formation Commissions; and,

WHEREAS, Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission has reviewed the Bill in detail and believes that it does not serve the public interest to make these proposed modifications, including permissive authority for expanding LAFCO Commission to directly elected public members; and,

WHEREAS, the requirements outlines in Senate Bill 1736 provide for authority to cities to halt development in non-city areas on a unilateral basis without right of popular decision of input; and,

WHEREAS, this Commission is opposed to the provisions of Senate Bill 1736 unless made totally permissive on a local county basis.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Commissioners of Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission hereby oppose Senate Bill 1736; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to Senator Behr, Assemblyman Keene, County Supervisors Association of California and the CALAFCO Legislative Committee.
