RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION  
COMMISSION APPROVING/~~DENYING~~ FORMATION OF  
Greater Willits Ambulance District

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WHEREAS, an application for formation of a special district to be known as Greater Willits Ambulance District was duly filed with the Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission, together with supporting documents required by rules of said Commission on May 2, 1989; and,

WHEREAS, said application has been processed pursuant to the provisions of Division 3, Title 5 commencing with Section 56000 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, at the times and in the form and manner provided by law, said Executive Officer has given notice of public hearing by this Commission upon said application and prepared a report, including his recommendations thereon, said application and report having been presented to and considered by this Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was held upon June 5, 1989 as specified in said Notice of Public Hearing and in any subsequent hearings; and,

WHEREAS, at such hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, objections and evidence which were made, presented, or filed, and all persons present were given the opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to any matter relating to said application and report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the formation of a special district to be known as Greater Willits Ambulance District being identified in the files of the Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission as File No. 89-2 be and the same is hereby approved/~~denied~~ by the Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission, subject to the following conditions and terms:

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Conditions/ Greater Willits Ambulance District

1. The benefit assessment will include all land use classifications that could have cause or need for services provided by the District whose intent is to provide broad based and equitable assessment.
2. The Proposition 4 limit shall be established upon LAFCO staff review of the limit proposed by the applicant with any adjustment that seems appropriate. Applicant must submit the proposal within 15 days so staff can set the final limit and provide the data to the conducting authority prior to their hearing calling for the election. The applicant shall submit the limit language to the County Registrar of Voters along with their other ballot information for same election.
3. The question of formation of the Greater Willits Ambulance District shall be presented to the voters with the following issues to be listed directly on the ballot:
  - a. A special tax approved by 2/3 of the votes cast by voters upon such proposition as proposed by applicants, which tax will be used solely to support operation of the District;
  - b. A negative vote on the assessment tax will constitute a negative vote on the formation.
  - c. The Proposition 4 limit, (once determined \$250,000.00 include amount) shall be printed on ballot.
  - d. Election of the Board of Directors
4. The Mendocino County Board of Supervisors is designated as the conducting authority for further proceedings, in this case calling for voter election for the formation and associated tax.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Executive Officer of said Commission is hereby authorized and directed to mail copies of this Resolution in the manner as provided by law.




