WHEREAS, a proposal for the proposed annexation of certain territory to the <u>Alexander Estates Lighting</u> District has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Local Agency Formation Commission pursuant to Title 5, Division 3, commencing with Section 56000 of the Government Code; and ,

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has reviewed the proposal and prepared a report, including his recommendation thereon, the proposal and report having been presented to, and considered by this Commission; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined to the satisfaction of this Commission that all owners of land included in the proposal consent to this annexation; and,

WHEREAS, this Commission called for and held a public hearing on the proposal on Sep. 9, 87 and at the hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written protests, all persons present were given an opportunity to hear and be heard with respect to this proposal and the report of the Executive Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mendocino Local Agency Formation Commission DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the proposal is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to G.C. Section 15303 Class 3 (d).
- 2. The proposal is hereby approved/denied subject to the conditions and terms being identified in Exhibit A.

- 3. The boundaries, as set forth in the proposal, are hereby approved as submitted. Exhibit B.
- 4. The territory includes 10.46 acres, is found to be waximhabitæd inhabited, and is assigned the distinctive short form designation: Annexation to the Alexander Estates Lighting District.
- 5. The Alexander Estates Lighting District District Board of Directors is designated as the conducting authority and is hereby authorized to conduct subsequent proceedings in compliance with this resolution.
- 6. The Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to mail certified copies of this resolution as provided in Section 56853 of the Government Code.
