Annexation No. 92-2 to the Albion-Little River Fire

WHEREAS, a proposal for the proposed Annexation No. 92-2
~~annexation~~ to the Albion-Little River Fire Protection District
has been filed with the Executive Officer of this Local Agency
Formation Commission pursuant to Title 5, Division 3, commencing
with Section 56000 of the Government Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has reviewed the proposal and
prepared a report having been presented to, and considered by
this Commission; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined to the satisfaction of this
Commission that all owners of land included in the proposal
consent to this annexation; and,

WHEREAS, this Commission called for and held a public
hearing on the proposal on April 5, 1993 and at the
hearing this Commission heard and received all oral and written
protests, objections and evidence which were made, presented or
filed, and all persons present were given an opportunity to hear
and be heard with respect to this proposal and the report of the
Executive Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mendocino County Local Agency Formation
Commission DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

1. The proposal, being identified in the files of the
Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission as File No. 92-2
be and the same is hereby approved/~~denied~~ subject to the
following conditions and terms:

1. Accept the Negative Declaration as adopted by the Albion-Little
River Fire Protection District and file with the County Clerk.
2. Designate the Albion-Little River Fire Protection District as
the Conducting Authority and authorize the District to proceed
with the public hearing processing pursuant to Government Code
Section 57000 et seq.

2. The boundaries, as set forth in the proposal, are hereby approved.

3. The territory includes 39 Square ^{miles} ~~ACRES~~, and is found to be ~~unincorporated~~/inhabited, and is assigned the distinctive short form designation: Annexation No. 92-2 to the Albion-Little River Fire Protection District.


4. The Albion-Little River Fire Protection District is designated as the conducting authority and is hereby authorized to conduct subsequent proceedings in compliance with this resolution.




WHEREAS, it has been determined that the fees presented in this resolution are based upon the Local Agency Formation Commission's actual cost of providing specific services; and,



* Incorporation applications will be subject to all actual cost for processing. This includes the State Controller's fee for the fiscal analysis, and the actual cost of the EIR. Deposits as noted above are due at the time of the application along with the LAFCO application fee.

** AB 3158 requires a fee be collected for Fish and Game for Negative Declarations and Environmental Impact Reports when filed with the County Clerk. This will be collected with LAFCO fees at time of application. Any other agency fees that are applicable to the filing of a Negative Declaration or Environmental Impact Report will be applied to the applicant for payment.
