

**LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION OF MENDOCINO COUNTY  
RESOLUTION 02-02**

**REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO COLLECT APPORTIONED FEES DUE TO  
LAFCO UNDER GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 56381**

*Whereas, Government Code Section 56381 details the requirements of the budget deliberation and budget process for LAFCO as well as the apportionment process for the county, cities and special districts and;*

*Whereas, the budget process has been publicly conducted as required and the final budget has been set with public input and;*

*Whereas, payment has been requested from all entities required to contribute to LAFCO's budget and;*

*Whereas, the County has paid in full their obligation; the cities have paid in full their obligations and; most districts have paid in full their apportioned amount and;*

*Whereas, after repeated request, a few special districts have not paid.*

*Therefore, pursuant to Government Code Section 56381(c) the Mendocino County Auditor is requested by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Mendocino County to collect from the entities that have not paid, such funds as is due this agency from the property tax, or any fee or eligible revenue owed to the districts.*

*Additionally, the Auditor is requested to maintain this resolution on file as a standing request from the Local Agency Formation Commission of Mendocino County for subsequent fiscal years and to take action under 56381(c) as appropriate for all entities that do not pay within the requested time period.*
