RESOLUTION NO. 79-9

RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS  
ON THE PROPOSAL DESIGNATED AS:

East Cedar Street Annexation  
to the City of Fort Bragg

(LAFCO FILE NO. 79-2 )

WHEREAS, the District Reorganization Act, in Sections 56000 et. seq. of the Government Code, does establish certain preliminary procedures which shall apply to proposals such as East Cedar St. Annexation to the City of Fort Bragg and,

WHEREAS, the Preliminary Proceedings were initiated when the Executive Officer of the Commission accepted for filing the subject application and issued a Certificate of Filing on 13 July 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

The short term designation for the affected territory shall be East Cedar Street Annexation to the City of Fort Bragg; and,

The affected territory shall be bounded as described in the attached Legal Description; and,

The affected territory is inhabited as defined by Section 56045 of the Government Code; and,

The Executive Officer did set the proposal for hearing on August 6, 1979 and did give notice at the time and in the manner prescribed by law; and,  
The Executive Officer did review the application filed with him and did prepare a report, including his recommendations, thereon; and,

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, the Commission has made approval of this proposal contingent upon the adoption of a Negative Declaration of Environmental Impact: and,

The Commission, at their meeting of 6 August 1979, held a public hearing as noticed, and heard and received all oral and written protests, objections or evidence which was made, presented, or filed, and considered the report of the Executive Officer and the plan for providing municipal services to the territory.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that:

The proposed East Cedar Street Annexation to the City Bragg of Fort is approved

with the following amendments and/or conditions;

1. The Commission must adopt a Negative Declaration of Environmental Impact for the proposal.
2. The proponents must correct technical deficiencies in the map and legal description to the satisfaction of the County Surveyor.
3. Detachment of the affected area from the Fort Bragg Rural Fire Protection District is simultaneously approved.
4. The proponents must submit to the Board of Directors of the Municipal Improvement District (The Fort Bragg City Council) a request for annexation to the subject area to the Improvement District.

The Fort Bragg City Council is designated as the conducting authority and is directed to initiate proceedings pursuant to the District Reorganization Act, in Sections 56290 et. seq. of the Government Code; and,

The Executive Officer shall mail a certified copy of this Resolution to:

- a. The conducting authority;
- b. The chief petitioner, if any; and,
- c. Each affected city, county and district.
