		ALCO DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PROPER

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE POTTER VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT, MAKING APPLICATION FOR THE ANNEXATION OF TERRITORIES TO SAID DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Potter Valley Irrigation District desires to initiate proceedings for the annexation to the said District of the territories hereinafter des cribed,

NOW, THEREFORE, The Board of Directors of the Potter Valley Irrigation District does hereby resolve, order and determine as follows:

Section 1: Application and a proposal is hereby made to the local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Mendocino for a change of organization as follows:

- 1. (a) This proposal is made pursuant to the District Reorganization Act of 1965, commencing with Section 56000 Government Code;
- (b) The nature of the proposed change of organization and the name of the District for which any such change or organization is proposed is as follows: The annexation of the hereinafter described territories to the Potter Valley Irrigation District;
- (c) The names of all other affected county, Cities, or Districts are:

The County of Mendocino; Potter Valley Cemetery District; Potter Valley Community Services District.

(d) The territory proposed to be annexed to the
Potter Valley Irrigation District is uninhabited territory. A
description of the exterior boundaries of such territory is set forth
in the copies of "Petition for Inclusion of Lands" of Erwin Wipf and
Anna M. Wipf, which is incorporated by reference as Exhibit "A" hereto,

the "Petition for Inclusions of Lands" of Quenten C. Siemer and Rose M. Siemer which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated by reference, and the "petition for Inclusion of Lands" of Charles C. Guntly and Elizabeth A. Guntly, which is incorporated by reference as Exhibit "C" hereto.

- (e) It is desired that the proposed annexations provide for and be made subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - [a] With respect to the lands of Erwin Wipf and Anna M. Wipf that they pay to the Potter Valley Irrigation District \$334.80 as a condition precedent; that they pay for the actual cost of any installation required and that the lands already within the Potter Valley Irrigation District have priority of right to water.
 - (b) That with respect to the lands of Quenten

 C. Siemer and Rose M. Siemer that they pay to the

 Potter Valley Irrigation District \$138.60 as a

 condition precedent; that they pay one-half the actual

 cost of installation of service, with the other onehald to be paid by Philip E. Nickerman and that the

 lands already within the Potter Valley Irrigation

 District have priority of right to water;
 - [c] With respect to the lands of Charles C.

 Guntly and Elizabeth A. Guntly that they pay to the

 Potter Valley Irrigation District \$529.80 as a

 condition precedent; that they pay for the installation

 of their own pump sump under district supervision and

 that the lands already within the Potter Valley

 Irrigation District have priority of right to water.
 - (f) The reasons for these proposals are as follows:

- [1] The Potter Valley Irrigation District is empowered to and is engaged in the supply and distribution of water for irrigation purposes and has existing supplies and facilities for the distribution of water for irrigation purposes sufficient to provide such water to the territories proposed to be annexed.
- [2] The territoriesproposed to be annexed to said district are suitable for irrigation and the development of such property to its best and highest use, requires that irrigation waters be supplied to such lands.
- 2. All the owners of the lands within the territories proposed to be annexed have given their written consent to such annexation as is more fully set forth in the Petitions for Annexations, Exhibits "A", "B" and "C" hereto. The Potter Valley Irrigation District therefore proposes that the commission, pursuant to Section 56261 of the Government Code of the State of California approve and authorize the Board of Directors of the Potter Valley Irrigation District to annex such territories without notice and hearing by the Board of Directors and without an election.

Section 2: The Secretary of said District is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Commission of the County of Mendocino.
