RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATIONS
ON THE PROPOSAL DESIGNATED AS:

North Fire Station - Old Treatment Plant Reorganization
City of Ukiah

(LAFCO FILE NO. 85-1)

WHEREAS, the District Reorganization Act, in Sections 56000 et. seq. of the Government Code, does establish certain preliminary procedures which shall apply to proposals such as North Fire Station - Old Treatment Plant Reorganization

_____, and
WHEREAS, the Preliminary Proceedings were initiated when the Executive Officer of the Commission accepted for filing the subject application and issued a Certificate of Filing on March 15, 1985.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

The short term designation for the affected territory shall be North Fire Station - Old Treatment Plant Reorganization
_____ ; and

The affected territory shall be bounded as described in the attached Legal Description; and

The affected territory is uninhabited as defined by Section _____ of the Government Code; and

The Executive Officer did set the proposal for hearing on April 1, 1985 and did give notice at the time and in the manner prescribed by law; and

The Executive Officer did review the application filed with him and did prepare a report, including his recommendations, thereon; and

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, the Commission has certified the proposal categorically exempt from CEQA as declared by the City of Ukiah ; and

The Commission, at their meeting(s) on April 1, 1985, held a public hearing as noticed, and heard and received all oral and written protests, objections or evidence which were made, presented, or filed, and considered the report of the Executive Officer and the plan for providing municipal services to the territory.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that:

The proposed North Fire Station-Old Treatment Plant Reorganization

is approved with the following amendments and/or conditions:

1. Detachment from the Ukiah Valley Fire Protection District

The City of Ukiah is designated as the conducting authority and is directed to initiate proceedings pursuant to the District Reorganization Act, in Sections 56439 et. seq. of the Government Code; and

The Executive Officer shall mail a certified copy of this Resolution to:

- a. The conducting authority;
- b. The chief petitioners, if any; and,
- c. Each affected city, county and district.
