- 1. The proposal is approved as submitted, with the proponent to make any corrections recommended by the County Surveyor and the County Assessor.
- 2. The Long Valley Fire Protection District Board of Directors is designated as the conducting authority to conduct further proceedings and to hold a protest hearing for the benefit assessment.
- 3. The approved application will be held by the Executive Officer until such time that the Benefit Assessment Hearing is conducted by the District, and if the results of the hearing are not successful, the annexation shall not be filed, but returned to the applicant.

- 2. The boundaries, as set forth in the proposal, are hereby approved.
