- Project Overview
 - Long Haul water from City of Ukiah to City of Fort Bragg
 - Treated through City of Fort Bragg
 - Made available for unincorporated hauling
- **Potential State Funding** for <u>Health & Human Safety</u>
 - Domestic Price = Water + Local Haul
 - Commercial Price = Water + <u>Long Haul</u> + Local Haul
- Designed to be **scalable** to other area if needed





WSRP Board Actions





4/20/21: Declaration of Drought Emergency8/24/21: Direction to develop & pursue hauling contracts

- Initial \$1.5M funding
- Direction to pursue State & Federal grants

8/31/21: Policy direction for County to cover 100% longhaul cost for domestic and 80% for commercial users





WSRP Status





- 1. Emergency Contract
- 2. Hauling began: 9/8/21
- 3. Initial Daily Volume: 10,000 gal
- 4. Need additional potable water trucks!
