The proponent is to make corrections to the legal description as recommended by County Surveyor prior to sign off on map.

- 2. The boundaries, as set forth in the proposal, are hereby approved.
- 3. The territory includes 2.32 acres, and is found to be uninhabited/imhabited, and is assigned the distinctive short form designation: Vincent Annexation to the Ukiah VAlley Sanitation District
- 4. The <u>Ukiah Valley Sanitation District</u> is designated as the conducting authority and is hereby authorized to conduct subsequent proceedings in compliance with this resolution.
- 5. The Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to mail certified copies of this resolution as provided in Section 56853 of the Government Code.
