RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING LAFCO FILING FEES

WHEREAS:

1. Section 54776.3 of the Government Code allows Local Agency Formation Commission to establish a schedule of fees for filing and processing applications, and
2. The Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission has reviewed current actual average staff time and resultant costs for processing applications,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission establishes the 1982-83 LAFCO Schedule of Fees as specified in Exhibit "A" attached to this Resolution, and incorporated herein by reference.

1982-83 LAFCO Schedule of Fees

I. Annexation, Detachment, and/or Reorganization Actions

Base fee:	0 - 10 acres	\$150
	10 - 30 acres	\$200
	30 - 50 acres	\$250
	50 - 100	\$300
	100 - 150	\$350
	150 - 200	\$400
	200 - 250	\$450
	250 +	\$500

II. Other Actions

Incorporation Proposal Fees	\$500
District Formation Proposal Fee	\$500
EIR Preparation Cost (LAFCO Lead Agency)	Cost of EIR + 20%

III. Fee Waiver

For any application involving solely tax-exempt property owned by Federal, State or Local Government agencies, all LAFCO fees shall be waived.

IV. State Board of Equalization

After final approval by LAFCO and the conducting authority, all proposals shall be filed with the State Board of Equalization. All state Board of Equalization fees shall be paid by proponents prior to completion of proceedings by the conducting authority.
