RESOLUTION APPROVING ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY

to the City of Ukiah

Designated as, Kennedy Annexation, File #74-2

The following resolution is now offered and read:

WHEREAS, a petition for annexation of territory to the City of Ukiah
_____ was duly filed with the Mendocino County Local Agency
Formation Commission on May 21, 1974; and

WHEREAS, said petition has been processed pursuant to the provisions
of Chapter 6.6 of Part 1, Division 2, Title 5 of the Government Code of the
State of California; and

WHEREAS, at the times and in the form and manner provided by law, said
Executive Officer has given notice of public hearing by this Commission upon
said petition; and

WHEREAS, said Executive Officer has reviewed said petition and prepared
a report, including his recommendations thereon, said petition and report
having been presented to and considered by this Commission; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing by this Commission was held upon the
date and at the time and place specified in said Notice of Public Hearing
and in any subsequent hearings; and

WHEREAS, at such hearing this Commission heard and received all oral
and written protests, objections and evidence which were made, presented, or
filed, and all persons present were given the opportunity to hear and be heard
in respect to any matter relating to said petition and report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED That the annexation of
territory to the City of Ukiah being identified in the files of the

Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission as File No. 74-2,

designated as Kennedy Annexation to the City of Ukiah

be and the same is hereby approved by the Mendocino County Local
(approved/denied)
Agency Formation Commission, subject to the following conditions and terms:

1. That a drainage study be made by a qualified engineer to determine proper size of drainage structure necessary to safe access and proper drainage, on Doolin Creek and adjacent properties.
2. That the property annexed be detached from the Ukiah Valley Fire Protection District.
3. Under Government Code Section 54797.1 annexation may be approved without notice, hearing or election

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Executive Officer of said Commission is hereby authorized and directed to mail certified copies of this resolution in the manner as provided by law.
