A RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION OF MENDOCINO COUNTY ESTABLISHING A SEPARATE FUND ACCOUNT FOR LAFCO

WHEREAS, the Mendocino Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) wishes to establish its own fund account separate from the Mendocino County Auditor-Controller; and

WHEREAS, Mendocino LAFCo is capable of managing a system of accounts to adequately track Commission revenues, expenditures and reserve funds; and

WHEREAS, Mendocino LAFCo will continue to have an Annual Audit prepared to verify all revenues and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, Mendocino LAFCo is a government agency and is not required to obtain a Federal Employer Identification Number.

NOW, THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the Mendocino Local Agency Formation Commission as follows:

- 1. Mendocino LAFCo hereby requests that the Mendocino County Auditor-Controller transfer LAFCo funds as reflected in the current Cash in Treasury Report to a bank account established by the Commission.
- 2. Mendocino LAFCo hereby requests that the Mendocino County Auditor-Controller continue to collect apportionment contributions from the County, the Cities, and the Independent Special Districts pursuant to Government Code Section 56381 (b).
- 3. Mendocino LAFCo shall file periodic claims with the Mendocino County Auditor-Controller in order to receive said apportionment contributions.
- 4. Mendocino LAFCo shall establish bank · accounts with the Mendo Lake Credit Union as necessary to conduct the Commission's financial transactions, including but not limited to a savings account and a checking account. The Executive Officer is hereby authorized to open such accounts.
- 5. Deposits to said accounts shall be verified by the Executive Officer and reported monthly to the Commission.

- 6. Authorization for payments from said accounts shall be the responsibility of the Executive Officer; except that payments to the Executive Officer shall be authorized by the Commission Chair or Vice Chair following approval of such claims by the Commission. LAFCo Resolution No.
- 7. The Executive Officer and the Executive Committee members shall be authorized to sign checks for payment; with each check requiring two signatures.
