

RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION
REQUESTING MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO DISSOLVE WATER
WORKS DISTRICT # 1.

WHEREAS, this Local Agency Formation Commission in Resolution #68-11 recommended the dissolution of Water Works District #1, and directed their Executive Officer and Legal Counsel to commence action in this regard; and,

WHEREAS, on March 10, 1969, a public hearing was held where seven petitions for dissolution of Water Works District #1 were received from property owners within the District; and,

WHEREAS, after public hearing it was established that the District has been in existence since 1955 and has not had a duly selected Board of Directors since that time; and,

WHEREAS, there have been no levies or collection of taxes, assessment, service charges, rentals or rates within this District and this District has no assets of any kind.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission hereby request that Mendocino County Board of Supervisors take immediate action to dissolve Water Works District #1 as provided under Section 56360 of the Government Code of the State of California.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Avila, seconded by Commissioner Pennock, and carried this 10th day of March 1969, by the following vote on roll call:
