Three consultant firms responded to the request for proposals (RFP) to prepare a Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) for the proposed City of Ukiah Sphere of Influence (SOI) Reduction. They were Michael Baker International with Land Logistics; Leonard Charles Associates; and LACO Associates. All proposals included the information requested in the RFP. Mendocino LAFCo staff and legal counsel reviewed the proposals using the following proposal evaluation criteria:

Understanding of the scope of work to be performed

- o Demonstrated understanding of the project objectives
- Consultant's approach to accomplishing the scope of work

Consultant's methods and procedures to be used

- o Consultant's general approach to evaluating the issues
- o Complete description of the procedures and analytical methods to be utilized

Cost and Schedule

o Timetable and costs for completing the project

Selection Recomendation

All three firms offer good EIR preparation experience. LACO Associates ranked highest on approach on scope and approach to evaluating issues. They offered the lowest bid of the three proposers and have an office in Ukiah. All three offered similar schedules for completing the project and scored well on procedures and analytical methods.

Legal counsel offered the following evaluation: I was most impressed with the LACO proposal which clearly spelled out an approach as an entirely new sphere that I think will avoid a number of issues that often trip up other environmental reviews. In particular, there is a tendency by consultants to use the prior planning document as the baseline and argue that the new plan has fewer environmental impacts than the old plan.

Based on this, staff recommends that the Commission select LACO Associates to prepare the City of Ukiah SOI Reduction PEIR and authorize the Commission chair to sign an agreement for services, as provided by legal counsel, and subject to deposit of funds by the City of Ukiah.
